CRITERIA FOR THE GRANT

AID OF NARGC GROUSE PROJECT PROPOSALS

1. A minimum 1,000 acres of core area which constitutes as suitable grouse habitat must be in place.
2. A long-term commitment from the owners of those lands must exist.
3. An active local group or grouse committee proposing the Project must be in place.
4. Potential sites will be inspected by a person knowledgeable in grouse management and husbandry.
5. Project owners must be aware of the shooting rights and the effect this may have on the long-term viability of their Project.
6. Applications must be submitted by the RGC Secretary, to the Secretary of the NARGC Grouse Sub-Committee or the NARGC National Secretary.
7. The closing date for applications shall be August 1st in each calendar year.
